MAINTENANCE & PRESERVATION OF DISTRICT SCHOOLS

Replace rusty piping and leaky roofs, failing electrical and HVAC systems, and asbestos abatement in decades-old elementary schools, creating safer, healthier spaces for students to learn and grow.



CREATE FUNCTIONAL LEARNING SPACES

Fund critical upgrades, transforming outdated classrooms, cramped bathrooms, and undersized libraries into functional spaces.



SAFETY & TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENTS

Enhance school security by closing gaps in fencing, install door monitoring systems, upgrade building access controls, and add alarms to reduce unauthorized entry risks.



ADA IMPROVEMENTS

Make upgrades to improve ADA accessibility to ensure that all students, staff, and community members can have equitable access to school grounds, playgrounds, bathrooms and facilities.



CTE PROGRAM EXPANSION

Update, expand, and improve job training classrooms and labs for high school and middle school students and extend programs at the elementary level to meet growing demand for career and technical education.



ENERGY SAVINGS

Make energy saving improvements to HVAC, windows, and lighting systems to schools and facilities that will save thousands of dollars in future utility costs.

HOW MUCH?



The overall tax rate is projected to increase by no more than \$1.23 per \$1,000 of taxable value annually. Based on the median assessed home value in Oregon City of \$271,000*, this investment amounts to **just over \$6 per week — about the cost of a coffee.**
